

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN AMATEUR WALKERS CLUB.

NEXT SATURDAY - SEPTEMBER 15TH, 1962 - S.A. 50 KILOMETRES ROAD WALKING CHAMPIONSHIP.

DISTANCE: 31 Miles 120 Yds. *14.8 ins.*

COURSE: This race will be conducted on the road circuit surrounding Victoria Park Racecourse; East Terrace, Wakefield Road, Victoria Terrace and Beaumont Road. This Course is 2 Miles 731 Yds. around. The race will start 583 Yds. in advance of the finishing line, and when competitors reach the finish for the first time they have 12 laps to go. Therefore the first lap is 2 Miles 148 Yds., and the other 12 laps are each 2 Miles 731 Yds making in all a distance of 31 Miles 120 Yds. (50 Kilometres).

STARTING TIME: Being such a long race (5 Hours) this race will start at 9.30 a.m. "SHARP".

CHANGING FACILITIES: Adelaide Harriers Club Shed. Please be there at 9.00 a.m., so that we can be ready to leave for the Start at 9.20 a.m.

DETAILS: Being a Championship, the race will be a scratch race with a Sealed Handicap.

UNIFORM: This is a State Championship, and each Competitor is requested to wear his Club Uniform, and Registered Number

EATS DURING RACE: If you desire to eat during the race, please bring your own eats, and they will be served to you.
