

RACE:- 7 MILES ROAD WALKING HANDICAP

VENUE:- EDINBURGH AIRFIELD

TIME OF STARTING:- This race will start at 2.00 p.m. SHARP.

MEETING PLACE:- All Competitors are asked to meet at The Thistle Hotel, Waymouth Street, Adelaide at 1.00 p.m. From there a ride to Edinburch will be arranged for you. We have to meet Terry Clark at the Edinburch Airfield Gates at 1.30 p.m. Any Walker living North of Adelaide, who wishes to travel straight to Edinburch is asked to be at the Airfield Gates at 1.30 p.m.

DETAILS:- The 7 Miles Course will be made of two laps. One Lap of 4 Miles and one Lap of 3 Miles. It is not yet known which lap will be walked first.

FACILITIES:- Changing and Showering facilities are available.

AFTERNOON TEA:- Walkers are asked NOT to bring Afternoon Tea next Week, as there is a Canteen available for eats and drinks, after the event.

HANDICAPS:- This race will be a straightout handicap, with all walkers leaving at different intervals. Due to Monday, June 4th, being a Public Holiday, the handicaps were not available for publication in this little newsletter, but walkers will be advised of their handicaps prior to next week's race.
