SUGGESTIONS.

Yearly Trophies.

Consistency (Handicaps).

1st 10 points, then 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point for all other starters.

If less than 6 starters, points will be awarded in accordance with number of starters, e.g. five starters, 1st 5, then 4, 3. All others to finish, 1 point.

Style Award.

Judges will allot 3, 2 and 1 points to the best stylists each week and a yearly trophy will be awarded to highest scorer for season.

Uniform.

Gold and Blue singlet with monogram on left breast. White shorts. Race numbers to be worn each Saturday - Back and Front.
